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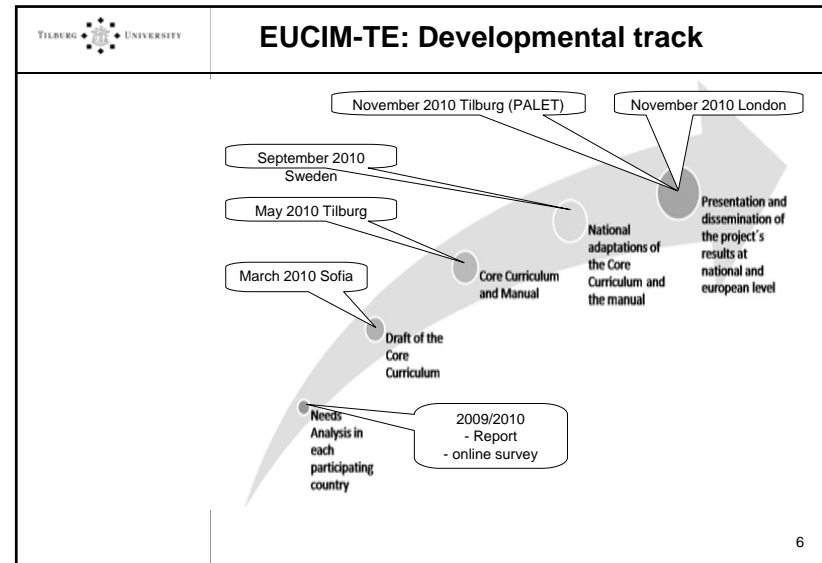
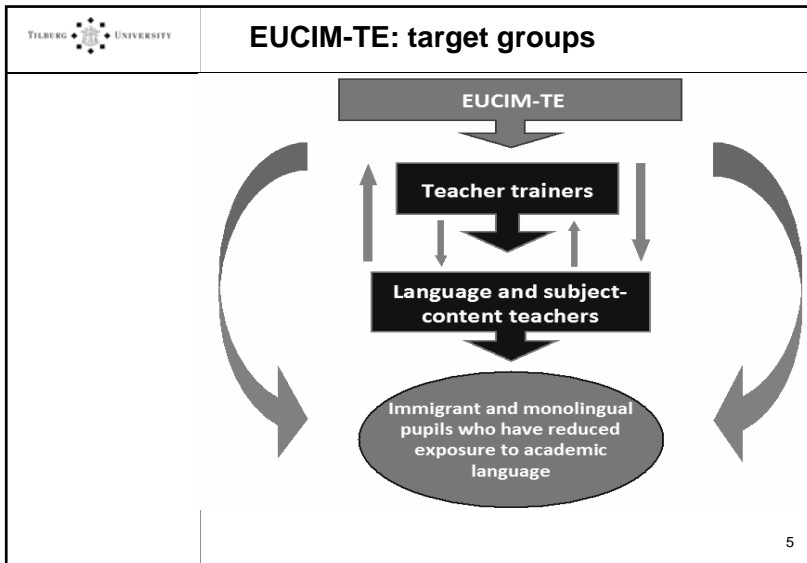
- Aim:

EUCIM-TE: main objective

- to improve the quality of pre- and in-service training of all teachers
 in relation to their work with (immigrant) pupils
- by creating a competence-based European Core Curriculum for teacher education

EUCIM-TE: specific aims

- Attitude change
 - > richness / problem of linguistic heterogeneity
- Awareness raising
 - > Inclusive role of language (across all subjects)
