Network website (www.get-in.info) was created as a communication platform for the target group of pupils, teachers, specialists, policy makers etc. to share information and ideas, to create mutual partnerships for more projects that will include more ethnic minority pupils (especially girls) in international school projects.
- With www.get-in.info ;
 - You can get news about the Get-in! and other networks' activities, follow the latest announcements on the thematic field
 - You can get general information about the project (objectives, outcomes, country context etc.) and partner institutions, our projects and good practices etc.
 - You can use chat rooms (pupils or/and teachers) for communication during the process of developing an international project or to meet pupils and colleagues from all around Europe on special occasions like the European Day of Languages, International Women's Day, Holocaust Memorial Day, Martin Luther King Day etc.
 - You can use forum pages (pupils only, teachers only or/and general) to initiate a new project, to share your ideas, to find partners, to share documents, findings and photos during the project and also to disseminate your results
 - You can support us and researchers by filling out the poll questions and learn immediately what the results are and you can submit suggestions for new poll questions about the thematic issues to us
 - You can download the manual (in several formats), our newsletters, reports and plans, application and registration forms, partner search forms, presentations and invitations, other material for guidance, for teaching etc.
